TENSION emerged at the bus stop near the Government Press in Mutyalampada, part of the Vijayawada Central Assembly constituency, on Thursday during a relay hunger strike organized by the YSRCP. The strike was held to protest alleged irregularities in the Mega DSC teacher recruitment process and was disrupted by leaders from the TDP, leading to heated arguments and a brief clash between supporters of both parties before police intervened.

As part of a statewide agitation, the YSRCP organized the hunger strike to demand a CBI inquiry into the alleged irregularities surrounding the Mega DSC-2025 teacher recruitment. The protest was led by former Vijayawada Central MLA Malladi Vishnu, who accused the recruitment process of having paper leaks, irregularities in selections, and a lack of transparency. He called for a fair investigation to ensure justice for the aspiring teacher candidates.

The situation turned tense when government whip and Vijayawada Central MLA Bonda Umamaheswara Rao arrived at the protest venue along with TDP leaders and supporters. Objecting to the relay hunger strike, he questioned the setting up of the protest camp on a public road without prior permission and demanded that the tents be removed. As TDP workers attempted to remove the tents, YSRCP leaders and activists resisted, leading to a heated altercation. Rally party workers raised slogans against each other, and the confrontation soon escalated into pushing and jostling, creating tension in the area.

In response, TDP leaders displayed a large banner at the bus stop, highlighting

the coalition government's achievement of recruiting 17,000 teachers through the Mega DSC initiative, framing it as a significant accomplishment. The move was perceived as a counter to the YSRCP's campaign. Tensions rose further as workers from both parties exchanged words, raised slogans, and engaged in pushing matches. Police quickly arrived to separate the two groups and restore order. Security was increased in the area, and traffic was briefly disrupted before normalcy returned.

Amid the chaos, YSRCP supporters, under the leadership of Vishnu, protested against the actions taken by Bonda Uma. Subsequently, police arrested Vishnu along with several YSRCP leaders and activists, escorting them away from the protest site.

Following Vishnu's arrest, Bonda Uma, together with TDP leaders and supporters, staged a dharna at the location, demanding action against the YSRCP for what they labeled an unauthorized protest on a public road. In a bid to prevent further escalation and restore order, police later detained Bonda Uma and several TDP activists.

The incident created a charged political atmosphere in Vijayawada, with both parties exchanging accusations regarding the Mega DSC recruitment process.

The YSRCP reiterated its demand for a CBI probe into the alleged recruitment irregularities, while the TDP defended the recruitment drive, asserting that political protests should not obstruct public movement or violate regulations governing the use of public roads.

AP records over six-fold surge in FDI under TDP govt

NEW DELHI: ANDHRA Pradesh has witnessed a sharp rise in Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) under the Chandrababu Naidu-led coalition government, according to official data shared by the Union government in Parliament. Replying to a question raised by YSRCP MP Maddhira Gurumothini in the Lok Sabha, the Centre said Andhra Pradesh received 608.59 million dollars in FDI in FY 2025-26, compared to just 92.13 million dollars in FY 2023-24, the last full financial year of the YSRCP government. This marks an increase of more than six times in less than two years.

The data also shows a steady rise in investments after the TDP government assumed office. FDI inflows increased from 92.13 dollars million in FY 2023-24 to 233.14 million dollars in FY 2024-25, before rising further to 608.59 million dollars in FY 2025-26. In effect, the government received more than doubled FDI in its first year and nearly tripled it in its second year.
