Indian Railways to run 112 special trains for Onam

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, Aug 7 (PTI)

INDIAN Railways will run 112 special train trips during the Onam festival season to handle the expected surge in passenger traffic, with Southern Railway operating 54 services and other zonal railways running the remaining 58.

According to an official release, the special trains will operate mainly between August 14 and September 6, connecting Kerala with major cities in Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal.

Southern Railway said it will operate 38 special trips within its network and 16 inter-railway special trips linking Kerala with neighbouring railway zones. South Western Railway, South Central Railway and South Eastern Railway will together run 58 additional special services to and through Kerala.

SC refuses to entertain plea for FIR, probe against former HC judge

NEW DELHI, Aug 7 (PTI)

THE Supreme Court on Friday refused to entertain a plea seeking registration of an FIR and court-monitored probe into the purported discovery of huge stash of cash following a fire at the residence of former Allahabad High Court judge Yashwant Varma.

A bench of Justices PS Narasimha and Alok Aradhie dismissed the petition filed by advocate Ghanshyam Upadhyay, who contended that mere resigning from office does not erase criminal liability for unaccounted money. The bench said earlier also a similar petition was dismissed.

Upadhyay submitted that the earlier petition was dismissed on technical ground that no complaint was filed but in this case, he has filed a complaint. Justice Narasimha told him, “You are an advocate. This is just a misuse of the judicial process. All for cheap publicity. We are not inclined to entertain this. Dismissed.”

Upadhyay said there is no reason for not entertaining the petition as a judge of the high court has been held to be a public servant.

“Now he is retired also. There is no immunity from prosecution,” he submitted.

The top court, however, refused to entertain the petition and dismissed it. On April 9, Varma, who was facing impeachment proceedings for his removal over allegations of corruption after wads of burnt currency notes were recovered from his residence in Delhi last year, resigned. The rare removal proceedings initiated by the Lok Sabha against Justice Varma was rendered “infructuous” following his resignation with immediate effect.

Amid the ruckus created by the BJP legislators, Speaker Rabindra Nath Mahato urged them to go back to their seats.

“Our Government will keep supporting the handloom sector, which is an important pillar of rural empowerment, women-led development and fulfilling the dream of an Atmanirbhar Bharat,” he said in a post on ‘X’.

The Prime Minister also appealed to people to share their favourite handloom products and GRWM (Great Ready With Me) videos using the hashtag “#NationalHandloomDay”, and

Doctors assault case: HC grants bail to Shiv Sena corporator Ramesh Mhatre

MUMBAI, Aug 7 (PTI)

THE Bombay High Court on Friday granted bail to Shiv Sena corporator Ramesh Mhatre, accused of assaulting doctors at a municipal hospital in Thane district, and ordered that the trial be fast-tracked and completed in a time-bound manner.

The High Court also granted bail to the four other accused in the alleged assault case that had triggered a massive outrage last month.

A bench of Acting Chief Justice Ravindra Ghuge and Justice Gautam Ankhad imposed strict conditions on Mhatre and the other accused and ordered them to stay outside Maharashtra until

the chargesheet in the case is filed.

The bench in its order noted that an elected corporator is believed to be “for the people and by the people”.

“If such an elected person assaults his own voters, then it is an assault on the fabric of the democracy itself,” HC said.

“However, considering the fact that the investigation is now being carried out at a fast pace and the accused have now spent some time behind bars, we feel bail can be granted,” the court said.

The court has ordered all the accused to stay outside Maharashtra until the chargesheet is filed in the case.

Reach of handloom products in global markets can be expanded: President

NEW DELHI, Aug 7 (PTI)

THE country’s handloom sector offers significant employment opportunities, and the reach of these products in global markets can be expanded through e-commerce platforms, President Droupadi Murmu said on Friday.

Speaking at the 12th National Handloom Day celebrations here, she said about 35 lakh people are engaged in the sector and out of that over 25 lakh are women.

She also exuded confidence that the sector will become a strong foundation for the country’s inclusive development.

The reach of India’s handloom products to global markets can be further strengthened through e-commerce platforms, the President said.

JAMMU and Kashmir Chief Minister Omar Abdullah on Thursday supported Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) chief Mohan Bhagwat’s remark that “Gen Z grievances are genuine and protesting doesn’t make them anti-national”.

Referring to Mohan Bhagwat’s remark, the Chief Minister said it was encouraging that a distinction was made between opposing the Government and acting against the country.

“The good thing is that Mohan Bhagwat ji has acknowledged this distinction. Opposing the Government is not the same as opposing the country. In fact, opposing the Government is often beneficial for the nation because it helps correct mistakes wherever they occur,” he said.

On Thursday while addressing a gathering of around 2,000 Gen Z and Gen

Alpha members at India’s International Movement to Unite Nations (IIMUN) 15th anniversary event in Mumbai, Bhagwat said, “If Gen Z members are

agitating, they are not anti-national; they are our people. It is our next generation. You need a dialogue and rapport with them.”

Man charred to death after car catches fire

LUCKNOW, Aug 7 (PTI)

A 32-YEAR-OLD man was charred to death after his car caught fire on the Lucknow-Sitapur highway in Uttar Pradesh, police said. The incident took place around 10.30 pm on Thursday near Virendra Dharamkanta at Saraiya Bazar on National Highway-24. Although fire-fighters managed to douse the blaze, the car was completely gutted, police said.
