The Haryana Government is bringing 'Haryana Baba Shree Khatu Shyam Chulka na Dham Shrine Bill, 2026' in the upcoming monsoon session starting from August 2 to take over the management, administration and governance of the shrine.

as also to provide better amenities and facilities to the visiting devotees as well as securing the health, safety and convenience of disciples, pilgrims and worshippers, has been decided to enact the 'Haryana Baba Shree Khatu Shyam Chulanka Dham Shrine Bill, 2026,'" stated the state government.

The government will nominate seven persons as members of the Board, including two women who have distinguished themselves in service of the Hindu religion. A representative of Shri Shyam Mandir Samiti (registered), Chulna Dham, shall be nominated as member.

However, the government may appoint a tribunal which, after giving persons hearing to the priests and representatives of the board, shall recommend compensation for them. While making its recommendations to the board, the tribunal shall have regard to the income of the priests had been declining, said the Bill.

Earlier, the state government had brought an ordinance and had sent it to the Centre for consent as the matter is on the concurrent list. But the Centre advised bringing a Bill in this regard, said a senior official of the Urban Local Bodies Department.

Provisions of the Bill

As per the Bill, the ownership of the shrine and shrine fund will vest in the Baba Shri Khatu Shyam Shrine Board. The Chief Minister shall be the Chairman of the board and the Urban Local Bodies
