

# 3.64L students shifted from pvt to govt schools under AAP govt: Bains

## In 4.5 years, govt invested Rs 2,300 crore to reform school infrastructure: Minister

Chandigarh, August 18

PUNJAB EDUCATION Minister Harjot Singh Bains on Tuesday said that the Punjab government has transformed the state's education system through a Rs 2,300-crore reform programme.

Presenting the four-and-a-half-year status report of school education, Bains said that 3.64 lakh students have shifted from private schools to government schools since 2022. He attributed the transformation to the sustained focus of the state government on strengthening government schools.

Recalling the AAP's electoral promise, Bains pointed out, "AAP national convenor Arvind Kejriwal and CM Bhagwant Singh Mann went to every village and city and asked for one chance to fix Punjab's government schools. The people of Punjab showed their progressive mindset by giving 92 seats to the AAP on this very narrative. We honoured that trust." The Education minister noted that the education system inherited in 2022 was in shambles.

"A majority of schools had no boundary walls. Over 5,000 schools had no functional toilets. 4 lakh children were forced to sit on the floor. 500 schools had no drinking water. And textbooks arrived 5 months late. This was the reality of Punjab's education." Highlighting the scale of infrastructure transformation, he said, "The Bhagwant Mann government has invested Rs 2,300 crore in school infrastructure, averaging Rs 15 lakh per school, in the last four and a half years. As a result, 13,920 new toilets have been constructed and every school in the state now has functional toilets. 2 lakh desks have been distributed, ensuring that no child sits on the floor today." "Over 9,000 new classrooms and labs have been built, while over 10,000 interactive panels have

been installed in classrooms. In addition, 5,012 schools have been upgraded with advanced computer labs. All government schools in Punjab have now been equipped with Wi-Fi and 99.9 percent schools have boundary walls," he added.

Pointing to the pace of infrastructure development, Minister Bains said, "Think about this, 9,000 new classrooms have been constructed by our government. Calculate the days and divide. See how many were built every single day." Highlighting the expansion of facilities in government schools, the Minister said, "Government schools now boast sports facilities previously reserved for private institutions, including swimming pools, shooting ranges, basketball and tennis courts, Kabaddi mats, wrestling and boxing rings." He said, "The Bhagwant Mann government gave unprecedented exposure to teachers. Over multiple batches, principals were sent to Singapore, primary teachers to Finland and headmasters to IIM Ahmedabad for training." Speaking about security and maintenance in schools, Minister he stated, "Ex-Army personnel have been deployed as campus managers in all senior secondary schools. In addition, two security guards have been posted at every senior secondary school with over 500 students. Monthly cleaning funds ranging from Rs 3,000 to Rs 50,000 are now being provided to schools based on student strength."

# NGT slams pollution board for failing to collect fine from Jalandhar MC

THE NATIONAL Green Tribunal (NGT) has slammed the Punjab Pollution Control Board (PPCB) for its non-serious approach in collecting a Rs 8.4 crore fine from the Jalandhar Municipal Corporation for violating waste management rules.

The green body was hearing a matter regarding the unscientific dumping and creation of a legacy waste dump at the Wariana dump site in Wariana village of Jalandhar district.

In an order dated August 12, made available on Tuesday, a bench of NGT Chairperson Justice Prakash Shrivastava and expert member Afroz Ahmad

said the PPCB has filed a report, saying it has imposed an environmental compensation of Rs 9.3 crore on the Jalandhar Municipal Corporation for not complying with the solid waste management rules.

It said of the total fine amount, the department of local government through Punjab Municipal Infrastructure

Development Company has deposited only Rs 90 lakh.

"A sum of Rs 8.4 crore is yet to be recovered, but the reply of Respondent 5, PPCB, does not disclose any serious attempt to recover the said amount," the tribunal said. It took note of the submissions of the board's counsel that within two weeks, a communication will be sent

to the deputy commissioner to recover the remaining fine as "arrears of land revenue".

The tribunal also directed the board to conduct a spot inspection to assess the quantity of legacy waste at the site.

It further said, "The reply affidavit of Respondent 3 (Jalandhar Municipal Corporation) does not disclose the

timeline for clearing the legacy waste, as also the gap in daily generation and treatment of the waste within the limits of Municipal Corporation, Jalandhar." "Hence, we direct Respondent 3 to file a fresh affidavit within four weeks covering the above aspects," it said.

The matter is scheduled for further hearing on October 28.

## DGP inaugurates gender sensitisation training programme for Punjab Police

PUNJAB DGP Gaurav Yadav on Tuesday presided over the inaugural function of a training programme to equip police personnel with skills and understanding required for gender-responsive, rights-based and victim-centric policing, with special focus on women, children and other vulnerable sections.

The DGP inaugurated the three-day 'Round-III' training programme under the Gender Sensitisation Project "Mainstreaming of Women in Punjab Police" at the historic 134-year-old Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Police Academy (MRSPPA) in Phillaur. The initiative is an extensive impact assessment training programme spearheaded by the Community Affairs Division (CAD) of the Punjab Police in partnership with J-PAL South Asia (Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty Action Lab) and the Hartek Foundation, an official statement said.

This is the final and concluding round of gender sensitivity training being conducted in three rounds since December 2025. The Round-III training will cover a total of 1,453 nominated police officials in specialised groups including Mixed Group (T3) on Day 1, Male-only Group (T2) on Day 2 and Female-only Group (T1) on Day 3.

"Through three statewide training rounds, 1,500-2,000 police personnel from 384 police stations are being equipped with the essential skills and understanding required for gender-responsive, rights-based and victim-centric policing, with special focus on women, children and other vulnerable sections," said the DGP.

Presiding over the inaugural ceremony, DGP Yadav emphasised the necessity of citizen-centric policing and exhorted officers to bring empathy and sensitivity to their daily interactions with all complainants who approach police stations. He pointed out that the Punjab government has implemented 33 per cent reservation for women in government services including the police department.
