

1 terrorist killed in Kashmir forest, 1-2 others trapped

A DAY after a brief exchange of fire in the forests of Yusmarg in central Kashmir, an unidentified terrorist has been killed in a joint operation by the Army and Police.

While security forces believe 1-2 terrorists are still trapped in the area, the combing operation has been extended into the dense forests.

“Based on specific intelligence input, a joint search operation was launched by [the] Indian Army, Jammu and Kashmir Police and the central reserve police force (CRPF) in [the] general area Ashdar Gali, Budgam,” the Army’s Srinagar-based Chinara Corps said. “Vigilant troops observed suspicious activity,

and upon being challenged, terrorists opened fire, prompting a fierce exchange of gunfire during which One terrorist neutralised and one AK rifle and other war-like stores re-

covered.” This comes after a shootout between terrorists and security forces in the forested area of Ashdar Gali in central Kashmir’s Budgam on Thursday.

Ashdar Gali lies above the famous Yusmarg tourist resort and connects Kashmir Valley’s Budgam to Poonch in Jammu region. The area has thick forests and borders the districts of Budgam and Poonch.

After the exchange of fire, the joint team tightened the cordon and launched a combing operation.

During intensified searches, the forces again came into contact with the terrorists, who opened fire while trying to break the security cordon.

The joint team returned fire, officials said, adding that intelligence inputs point to the presence of 1-2 more terrorists in the forests, prompting intensified searches. “This is only the second gunfight between security forces and terrorists in the Valley this year.

Three boys drown while bathing in Jharkhand river

THREE BOYS drowned while bathing in the Tadgao River here on Friday. The bodies of all three have been recovered, police said. The incident took place around 10 am in Ghurnadih village in Jharkhand’s Chatra, they said.

“We recovered the body of Satyam Kumar (12), who had gone missing... The bodies of the other two boys were recovered with the help of locals soon after the incident, while a search operation was underway to trace the missing boy,” Sadar police station officer-in-charge Anil Oraon told PTI.

The other two deceased have been identified as Prince Kumar (16) and Ansh Prakash (11), police said.

As Penguin deal falls through, Sonia Gandhi book to be now published by HarperCollins

A WEEK after *The Indian Express* reported that the deal between Penguin Random House India and senior Congress leader Sonia Gandhi to publish her memoir had fallen through, HarperCollins India has announced it will publish the book, titled *Belonging: A Journey of Love* by Sonia Gandhi.

The memoir, the publisher said in a post on X, will be published in India on 10 November 2026. “One of the most anticipated political memoirs of our time, *Belonging* is a dramatic and deeply personal story of love, identity, duty and belonging, and offers a rare insider’s view of India’s journey,” the post added.

The Indian Express was the first to report that Penguin Random House India would not proceed with the memoir’s publication after Sonia Gandhi turned down some “editorial changes and deletions” suggested by the publisher.

The Indian Express report had also mentioned that HarperCollins was close to finalising the agreement to publish and distribute the book in

India. It is understood that several Indian publishers were in touch with the book’s agent, David Godwin, but were informed that the “deal” had been finalised with HarperCollins over 2 weeks ago.

Earlier, US-based Alfred A Knopf, a division of Penguin Random House, announced the book’s release scheduled for November 10. Knopf had said the first print run for the title would be 100,000 copies.

The publishing deal between Penguin Random House India and Sonia Gandhi fell through after a “back-and-forth” lasting at least two months.

Sources had earlier told *The Indian Express* that these deliberations were “cordial” at the outset but got “rough” towards the end. Among the passages that were objected to were: references to Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his 12-year rule; the role of the RSS; references to instances of communal divide and riots, and the plight of minorities.

Sonia Gandhi was represented by the wife of one of Rajiv Gandhi’s aides and a family friend. PRHI had a team of at least three editors, including consultants.

Sources said that the author’s side pushed back with two key arguments. One, that the Penguin Ran-

dom House India lawyers were being “over-sensitive.” And, two, that the “numerous” edits and deletions, as suggested by them — including mention of Prime Minister Narendra Modi or contemporary developments like the Indo-China stand-off in Galwan as well as mentions of communal strife and status of minorities — would lead to an awkward situation of two versions of the book, the global edition at variance with the Indian edition.

“Readers in India would have to compare the text of the title published globally to the one printed in India to know what all had been changed or censored,” said a source.

Fugitive wanted by FBI for \$600K fraud held in Punjab

PUNJAB POLICE has arrested an India-born US citizen wanted by the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) for a \$600,000 fraud in Washington. The FBI had announced a \$150,000 reward for information leading to Manjit Singh Bedi’s arrest.

Punjab’s Director General of Police Gaurav Yadav said on Friday that Jalandhar Police has caught Bedi.

According to FBI, Bedi is a naturalised US citizen: someone who was born outside the US and became a citizen through a formal process.

Bedi, the FBI alleged, defrauded the US government out

of at least \$600,000 between March 2024 and June 2025.

An FBI release said Bedi operated a small grocery store, named Asian Grocery Store, in Tacoma, Washington.

He purportedly sold food to beneficiaries of the Supplemental Nutrition and Assistance Program (SNAP) through their Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT)

cards.

It added that instead of selling SNAP participants food through their EBT cards, Bedi allegedly swiped the cards and gave them cash, keeping half the proceeds for himself.

“After being indicted for wire fraud and SNAP benefits fraud, Bedi was allowed to appear in court without being arrested. He

was ordered to give up his passport and remain in Washington state,” the FBI said.

“However, Bedi soon drove across the border to Canada and then fled to India. On May 21, 2026, a federal arrest warrant was issued for Bedi in the United States District Court, Western District of Washington, Tacoma, Washington,” it added.
