

Three pvt college students die in road accident

THREE students of a private university in Pallavaram died, and four others were injured after their car overturned due to a tyre burst and crashed into the road median on the Chennai-Tiruchy highway on Friday night. Police said the students were returning to Chennai from Puducherry after a trip when the accident occurred.

According to police, the seven students left for Puducherry in an SUV on Thursday with Harikrishnan (19) driving. Around 8.45pm on Friday during their return journey, they



reached Hotel Highway Inn near Maduranthakam when one of the car's rear tyres allegedly got punctured. Harikrishnan lost control of the vehicle, causing it to swerve across the road and overturn before hitting the central median. The impact of the crash killed two students - Deepakraj (19) of Vadalur in Cuddalore district and Beautrin Stalinijo

(22) of Kanniyakumari -- due to fatal head injuries. Raj Prasad (19) of Pasupathipalaiyam in Karur was rushed to the hospital, where doctors declared him brought dead. Deepakraj was a third-year arts student, Stalinijo was a final-year law student, and Prasad was a third-year BCom CA student.

The four injured students were identified as Logeswaran (18) of Karur; Ram Prasad (19) of Pasupathipalaiyam in Karur; Anishwaran (18) of Cuddalore; and Harikrishnan of Chennai. One was shifted to a nearby private hospital while the others are at Chengaplattu Government Hospital. All injured stu-

dents are in stable condition, hospital sources said.

Maduranthakam police have registered a case under Sections 281 (rash or negligent driving), 125(a) (endangering life and personal safety of others) and 106 (causing death by negligence) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

The crash caused traffic congestion on the highway for some time as police and emergency personnel shifted the injured and removed the vehicle from the road. The bodies of the three deceased have been sent for postmortem examination. Police are examining the circumstances of the crash.

K'taka to seek centre's nod for Mekedatu project: DKS

CHIEF Minister DK Shivakumar said on Saturday that the state government is getting ready to approach the central government to seek approval for implementing the Mekedatu project following a favourable Supreme Court ruling.

Speaking at the 111th Jayanti Mahotsav of Dr Sri Rajendra Swamiji at the Suttur Mutt branch, Shivakumar said Karnataka must conserve and effectively utilise Cauvery water for the benefit of farmers.

"Rural farmers should become stronger. Just as Kannambadi (KRS) reservoir is vital for our food security, we must work towards conserving Cauvery water. The Mekedatu project will help us make better use of the available water," he said. He said around 5,400 hectares of land, including forest patches, will be required for the project. "Preparations are being made to provide alternative land in lieu of the forest area. We have taken Opposition parties into confidence and are preparing to submit an application to the central government

for the Mekedatu project," he said.

He called for unity on issues concerning the country's land, water and language. "I spoke about Mekedatu during my recent visit to Tamil Nadu. I appeal to activists in the State to maintain peace," he said.

He termed the meeting of chief ministers of three states to address the Tungabhadra issue as a historic development. The Tungabhadra reservoir had accumulated around 33 tm-

ct of silt and the Centre has formulated a new policy to remove it, he pointed out.

Recalling his earlier participation in the struggle for Karnataka's water rights, Shivakumar said he had visited Bhagamandala during the agitation and sought the blessings of around 2,000 children.

"That struggle was successful. Now, the Supreme Court has also ruled in favour of the Mekedatu project," he said.

'NEET, 7.5% quota a boon for govt-school students'

M Thalayai, headmaster of Velanguli GHSS, said that following the introduction of the 7.5% quota, six students, including the three brothers, from the village school could join medical colleges.

"Our students P Anbarasan, whose father is also a weaver, and B Thirisha secured MBBS seats in 2021 and 2023, respectively. I am happy that former Higher Education Minister K P Anbalagan highlighted our students' achievements in the Assembly. Former Chief Minister Edappadi K Palaniswami has invited our students for a meeting with him," he said.

Speaking to *TNIE*, Anbarasan, who completed his MBBS this year and is preparing for NEET-PG, said NEET and the 7.5% reservation have been a boon for government-school students like him.

"We could not compete with private-school students when medical seats were allotted based on Plus Two marks. Not even 40 government-school students could enter medical colleges. With the introduction of NEET and the 7.5% reservation, we got an opportunity to secure medical seats. The number of students like us getting MBBS seats has now crossed 500 this year," he said.

Corporation steps up anti-dengue measures

Coimbatore: The Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) intensified anti-dengue measures across all five zones and 100 wards, with a focus on eliminating mosquito breeding sources in the monsoon season. From August 28, schools, colleges, hospitals and hostels in the corporation limits will be provided with a Weekly Anti-Larval Self-Inspection Checklist. The institutions have been asked to nominate a staff member to inspect their premises every week, record the findings and submit it to the ward health inspector. Under the "Operation Shield - Multi-Dimensional Activities Against Dengue" initiative, mosquito larvae are being destroyed within a 10-km radius of areas where dengue cases are detected.

Two kumki jumbos deployed to capture 'man-eater' in Nilgiris

TWO kumki elephants have been deployed to assist the forest department personnel in tracking and capturing the tiger that allegedly killed two men at Lauriston near O-Valley, on Friday evening.

The deployment of kumki elephants Boman and Udayan is expected to be an added advantage for the forest department, as veterinarians can get a better view of the tiger and attempt to dart it while sitting along with the mahouts on the elephants. The trained kumki elephants from Theppakkadu Elephant Camp in Mudumalai Tiger Reserve (MTR) are being used to navigate the rugged and treacherous terrain.

148 govt schools get daytime watchman

Coimbatore: The Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) has deployed daytime watchmen at 148 corporation schools. While some Corporation schools already had daytime watchmen, the CCMC filled vacancies at remaining schools. A headmaster of a Corporation school in the city told *TNIE* that the schools already had night watchmen. However, there was a demand for the appointment of daytime watchmen for safety of students as outsiders often entered school campuses during the day and instances of theft had also been reported.

Two assault sub-inspector during vehicle check, held

SINGANAILLUR police on Friday arrested two persons for attempting to murder a sub inspector during a vehicle check at Ondipudur on Friday.

The suspects were identified as S Abdul Rahman (46), and R Sekar (45). Abdul Rahman owns an automation company, while Sekar works there. The incident occurred around 11.45 pm on August 27, when police were conducting a vehicle check. When the police asked them to come out of the vehicle, they allegedly refused to comply. Police suspected that the duo were under the influence of alcohol.

When the SI attempted to photograph the suspects as part of registering a complaint against them, Abdul

Rahman allegedly resisted and assaulted him. The SI sustained an injury to his mouth, resulting in a broken tooth. Sekar subsequently joined Abdul Rahman and allegedly attacked the SI on his chest.

Abdul Rahman also allegedly took a jack lever from the car and threatened the police officer. The SI alerted the police control room, following which a team of police personnel reached the spot and arrested the duo.

Meanwhile, the injured SI was taken to a private hospital for treatment.

Based on a complaint from the SI, Singanailur police registered a case. They were arrested and subsequently remanded in judicial custody on Friday evening.



'DEOs not conducting spl teacher camps'

Coimbatore: The Tamil Nadu Elementary School Teachers Federation (TNSTEF) alleged that the Directorate of Elementary Education (DEE) failed to conduct camps to grant special and selection grades to government school teachers. TNSTEF district secretary C Arasu said, "District Educational Officers (DEOs) must conduct a camp every month but, they don't, and grievances are pending at the Chief Educational Officer's office." A teacher awaiting special-grade status said officers do not respond when inquired about the camp. A senior DEE official said that he would look into this issue and that camps would begin soon.
